In Class Assignment — Identifying Microaggressions

This assignment works well in a classroom where you have recently reviewed the concept of microaggressions and their particular characteristics. This is a good first assignment after having introduced the concept. This assignment asks students specifically to identify microaggressions, the message(s) communicated in the microaggressions and whether or not that message is implicit or explicit.
